C. Douglass Buck served as Governor of Delaware from 1929 to 1937.

The town was originally called Zwaanendael, which means "Swan Valley" in Dutch.

In 1682 when the Delaware colonies were given to William Penn by King Charles II. Penn changed the towns name to Lewes in honor of the town in Sussex County, England. Penn's hometown.

#### **LEWES MUSEUM?**

Zwaanendael Museum: Was built in 1931 to commemorate the 300th anniversary of the settlement.




